

DENR eyes development of eco-tourism park in Capiz

Iloilo City – The Department of Environment and Natural Resources – Western Visayas (DENR-6) is planning to develop a 400-hectare eco-park in Tapaz, Capiz.

DENR-6 Regional Director Jim Sampulna said that the proposed site is for the Sustainable Integrated Area and Development (SIAD), a program framework that is designed to curb rural poverty and promote a green economy.

The DENR will partner with the local government of Tapaz in implementing the project that also poised to be an eco-friendly tourist spot.
